NMDAC MEMBERSHIP LEVEL

Professional / Retired or Para-professional

These memberships are offered to health care professionals or para-professionals, promotoras, community health workers, and retirees who have an interest in the development, delivery, or administration of diabetes education, prevention, and care or who are involved in diabetes research.

Organizational Partner

This membership level allows up to five members of the organization to participate as full members.

Benefits of this membership:

Student

This membership level is for current students with an interest in diabetes prevention, education, care, and research. Must have a current college email address and list your learning institution to qualify for this membership.

Benefits of this membership:

- No fee for admission to each quarterly NMDAC training.

Sustaining Partner

This membership level allows up to 20 members of the organization to participate as full members.

Benefits of this membership:

- Same benefits as Organizational Partner Membership

PLUS:

- Up to 20 members can attend each training (savings of up to \$500)
- Opportunity to have one slide for the organization displayed at each training. Content must be approved by the board.
- Opportunity to have information table for in-person meetings
- Opportunity to include announcements in the NMDAC newsletter. Content must be approved by the board.
- No advertising of products allowed.
